

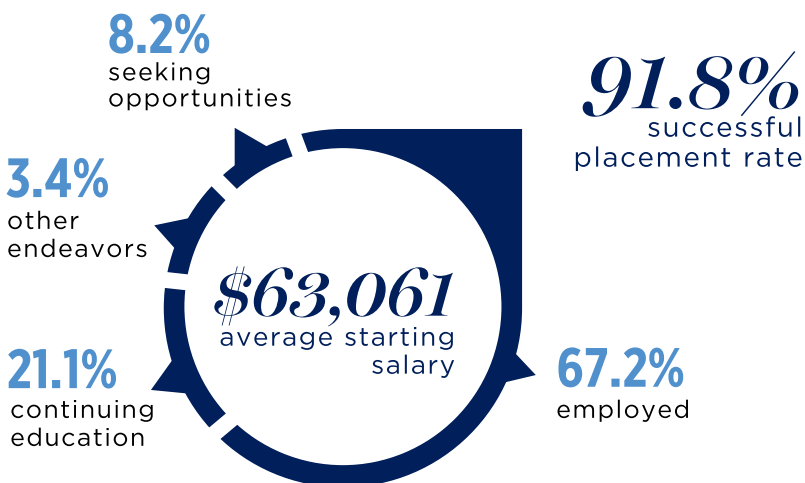

# HOW YOU CAN HELP

## Share your insights about what they might like
